

Open Age Cricket (e.g. Playing in Adult Cricket) – ECB Regulations

2013 Season

To Parent/Guardian

Detailed below are the 2010 ECB regulations the club is required to comply with.

Part 1: Any player in school Year 7 or below (Under 12 at midnight on 31st August in the year preceding the current season) CANNOT play in open age cricket with or without explicit written consent. (i.e. born after 31/8/1999)

Part 2: Players in Year 8 at school (Under 13 at midnight on 31st August in the year preceding the current season) to play in open age cricket providing ‘Explicit Written Consent’ to play in open age cricket has been obtained prior to play. (i.e. born between 31/8/1999 and 31/8/2000)

In respect of Part 2, please list below each child whose Date of Birth falls between **31/8/1999 and 31/8/2000**. Then delete as applicable one of the options in the ‘Consent’ column.

In **Consenting** you acknowledge;

- Being fully aware of the potential increased hazard associated with playing ‘adult’ cricket
- Giving explicit consent to the child playing Open Age Cricket (e.g. adult cricket)
